
A warm, funny tale of a timid pup who needs a friend.

Uptight elfin historian Brangwain Spurge is on a mission into the goblin kingdom. His host, the goblin archivist Werfel, is delighted to show Brangwain around. They should be the best of friends, but a series of extraordinary double crosses, blunders and cultural misunderstandings throws these two bumbling scholars into the middle of an international crisis that may spell death for them – and war for their nations. A hilarious and biting social commentary, this tale is rife with thrilling action and visual humour ... and a comic disparity that suggests the ultimate victor in a war is perhaps not who won the battles, but who gets to write the history.
